

User Profile Analysis at 30 June 2008

The Fund contains two main Groups: Group 1 Users were clients of the original Independent Living Fund which closed on 31 March 1993; Group 2 Users applied on or after 1 April 1993. The total number of Users at 30 June 2008 was 21,836 and this caseload is analysed in the tables below. At that date there were 726 applications in progress, plus 827 offers of financial assistance awaiting take-up.

There is a combined administration managing the two Funds, but separate figures for each Fund are maintained for policy application and accounting purposes.

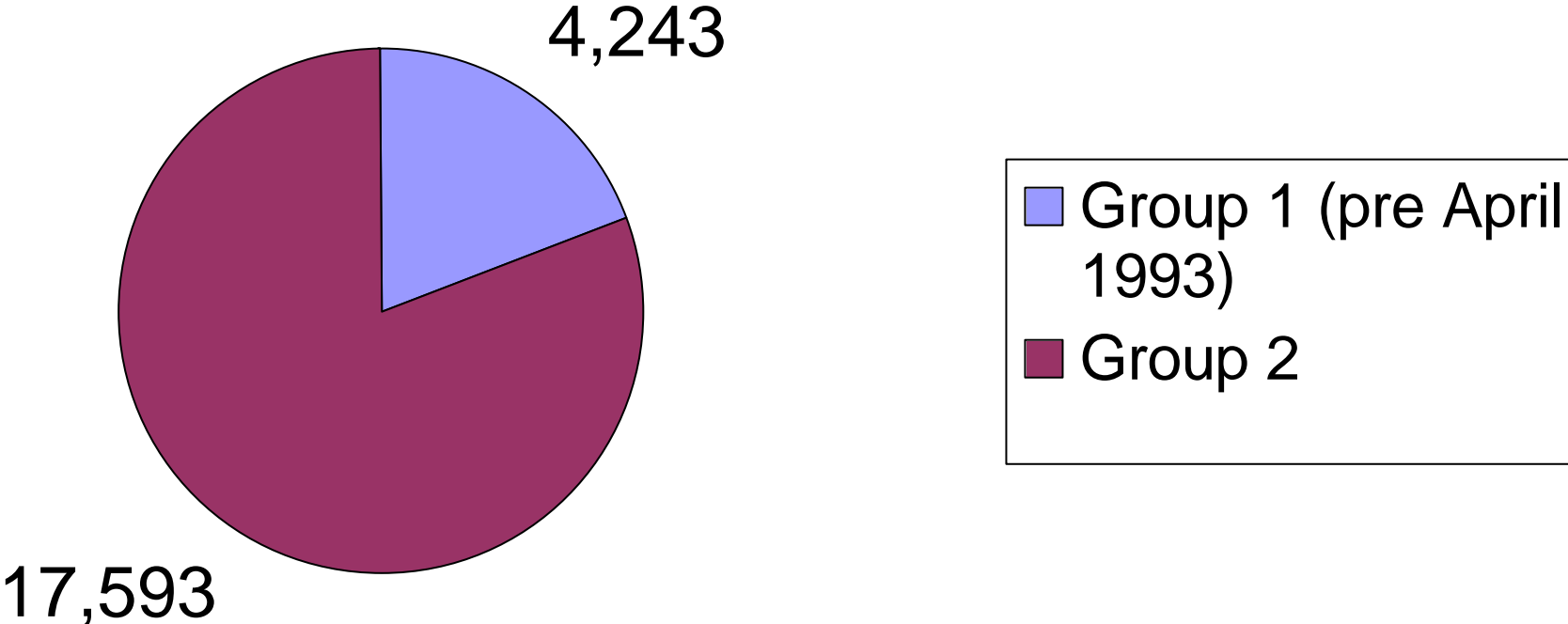

7 Geographical distribution of Users
